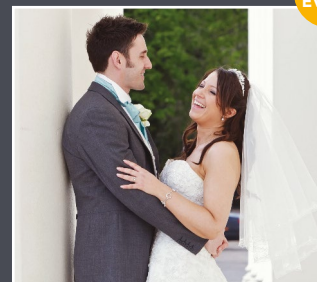

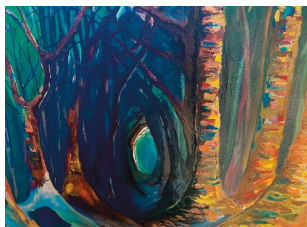
THE STABLES

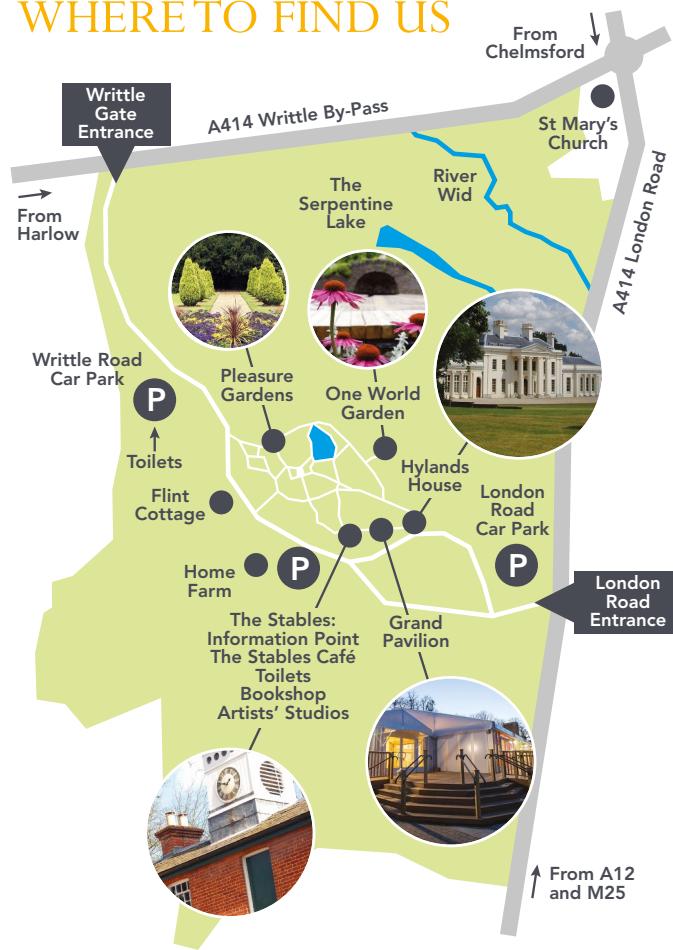
