About Tuesday Toddle

The Tuesday Toddle sessions are run approximately once every fortnight throughout the year, with a break during the school summer holiday period. The Toddles are an opportunity for parents with pre-school children to enjoy a guided walk in the park and garden areas surrounding Hylands House along with other parents with children of a similar age. The routes chosen for the walk consider those with pushchairs although a short detour may be necessary from time to time to avoid steps etc. The walk is followed by a craft activity which takes place in Hylands House or Grand Pavilion.

Extra measures have been put in place to prevent the spread of Covid 19. These measures include:

- Social distancing; please ensure you maintain two-meter social distancing in Hylands Park and in Hylands House and Grand Pavilion.
- The craft activity will take place in Hylands House or the Grand Pavilion not in the basement workshop, the change of location will enable everyone to socially distance.
- All adults must wear a face covering in Hylands House and the Grand Pavilion.
- Maximum of 15 children per session.
- All children must be pre booked and contact details will be kept for 21 days in line with track and trace.
- Drinks to be served in disposable cups.
- The session leader will carry sanitiser and gloves.
- All stationery and craft materials will be sanitised after each session.
- Hylands House and Grand Pavilion will be deep cleaned, including all touch points before and after each session.

Educational Benefits

The Tuesday Toddle is designed to offer educational benefits by fostering an appreciation of the natural environment and the seasonal changes. The sessions therefore take place even if the weather is less favourable! It is important that both children and parents are dressed appropriately for the weather conditions including suitable footwear so that children learn that the outdoors is a fun place to be. Remember sun hats and sun creams when the sun is out too.

Other benefits include the opportunity for toddlers to socialise with young people whilst still in the company of their parent/carer. During the craft activity the children are also starting to experience a learning environment like which they will meet when they start school. Your help in encouraging sharing, good behaviour and consideration for others is important to ensure everyone enjoys the sessions. Children will be having fun and will be nurturing the right feelings to help prepare them for times when they will have to deal with group situations on their own.



There are the obvious benefits for parents too of meeting with others who have children the same age and you can always arrange to meet up at other times for a walk and talk in the Park.

Safeguarding Children

Equality and Diversity

We aim to provide crafts and activities so that every child feels included as part of the group. Please let us know of any special needs to ensure your child fully benefits from the sessions. We also aim to provide an environment which promotes dignity and respect for all; please speak with the Session Leader if you have any concerns in this respect.

Medical

If you or your child has been in contact with anyone who has tested positive for Covid 19 in the last 14 days or had any symptoms (high temperature, new continuous cough, a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste), please DO NOT attend the session.

Whilst we love to share, we do not want to share unwanted germs! If your child has been unwell and has vomited or had diarrhoea within the last 48 hours, please do not bring your child to the Toddle session.

Nappy Changing

Nappy changing facilities are available in the disabled toilet located in the basement of Hylands House and in the Grand Pavilion.

Times

The times for Tuesday Toddle are from 10.00am to 11.30am. The session is planned so that those with older children can easily fit the visit to Hylands within the school day. If parents arrive late, they will find that the activity has already started – please therefore arrive on time!

In order that the sessions can run punctually please arrive 5 minutes early if this is your first Toddle along with completed copies of the Chelmsford City Council image consent form, emergency contact details and diversity monitoring forms.

- **Image Consent Form**

During the sessions there are often wonderful opportunities to take photographs of the children which we then use for marketing purposes. Children's names are never publicised and if you are happy for us to take photographs, we ask that you complete an image consent form.

- **Emergency Contact Details**



If something was to happen to the parent /carer during the Tuesday Toddle, we ask you to provide us with emergency details of a person who would be able to come immediately to care for your child. Any personal information will be held according to the Data Protection Act and will only be available to those responsible for the Tuesday Toddle group or to external authorities in the case of an emergency.

- **Equal Opportunities Information**

Chelmsford City Council aims to integrate equality and diversity into everything it does to ensure equality of service to all members of the community. To help monitor the effectiveness of our equality and diversity policies we would like you to complete a Diversity Monitoring questionnaire.

Health and Safety

There are of course health and safety risks whenever you are out and about with young people. Toddlers will be unaware of the risks and so you need to be aware that **you must take responsibility for your own children** during the session's activities. We will take bookings for one parent with up to a maximum of 3 children.

Some of the main risks which you should be aware of:

Outside in the garden areas

- Traffic in the car parking areas and approaches to the House
- Deep water in the pond areas in the Pleasure Gardens
- Children wandering away from the main party
- Dogs off lead in the park – a small child could be knocked down by an enthusiastic animal and we do not encourage anyone to touch strange dogs
- Collecting materials - sticks, leaves. Child may put dirty hands in mouth – please use wet wipes etc.

NB. Dogs are not permitted on the Tuesday Toddle, except for guide dogs.

Indoors

- Fire risk – ensure you make yourself aware of the fire exits.
- Limited space in the workshop – for this reason we must limit numbers. Please help us by keeping access routes clear (tuck bags etc. under tables)
- Pushchairs can block access – only bring a pushchair if necessary.
- Use of art materials – risks of spillages; health risks associated with consuming food during craft activities (we do not encourage food during the craft session).
- Hot drinks - could spill and scald children – no hot drinks are permitted

Evacuation Procedure from Hylands House and/or the Grand Pavilion:



If you discover a fire:

- ✓ Tell a member of staff
- ✓ Operate the nearest fire alarm point
- ✓ Call the fire service on 999
- ✓ Leave the building and go to the nearest assembly point

On hearing the fire alarm:

- ✓ Leave the building by the nearest available exit
- ✓ Report to the assembly point

The assembly point is situated on the back lawn (by the path to the gardens)

- Do not re-enter the building unless authorised to do so
- Do not use the lift

Smoking Policy

We operate a No Smoking policy throughout the Tuesday Toddle.
