


CREAMFIELDS SOUTH FESTIVAL 2022

Creamfields South and Hylands Park

The first ever **Creamfields South** comes to Hylands Park in early June during the Queen's Platinum Jubilee bank holiday. Creamfields replaces the V festival as the annual major music festival held at the estate.

Between 19 May and 14 June there will be some restrictions to keep everyone safe while this event is being set up and taken down.

There are 574 acres of parkland and gardens at Hylands Estate and much of the park will remain available to visitors apart from just a few days when the festival takes place. This includes the area around Hylands House and The Stables, the Pleasure Gardens, the east and south park areas, the Serpentine Lake, and the One World garden.

However, certain areas will be closed to the public for longer while heavy vehicles and machinery are operating on the main festival construction site. This includes the adventure castle play area and nearby car park.

Details about all the restrictions can be found in the text below and on the map overleaf. Please follow advice from security staff, safety signs and park notices when you are visiting Hylands during this period.

Key Dates

19 May – 14 June

- The **Writtle gate entrance** (entrance 2 on the map) on the A414 Greenbury Way, the **adventure castle play area and car park and public toilets** will be closed.
- An **overflow car park in the north-eastern corner of the park** next to the Parish Church of St. Mary in Widford (entrance 3 on the map) will also be **open** during this period to provide alternative parking. This parking area is separate to the church's own car park and can accommodate around 60 vehicles. A **temporary toilet will also be available at this site.**

30 May – 8 June

- **All permissive footpaths** through the estate (marked in red on the map overleaf) will be **closed**. These will reopen on 9 June.

1 June – 5 June

- **Hylands Park is closed for Creamfields South.** This applies to the whole park, including The Stables visitor centre and café, the Pleasure Gardens and One World Garden and all the estate's car parks. Entry to the park through the A414 dual carriageway **London Road entrance** (entrance 1 on the map) will only be available for pre-authorised access, such as those attending weddings at Hylands House. **These areas reopen on Monday 6 June.**

Other parks and green spaces

Chelmsford has 17 Green Flag parks, green spaces, and many recreation and play areas in addition to Hylands Estate. To find out more about alternative places to visit while Hylands Park is closed for Creamfields, go to loveyourchelmsford.co.uk.
